General Rules and Reminders for Users and Enforcers of the Trails

- 1) Permit is good for traditional ATV's only, vehicles such as mini trucks etc. are not allowed.
- *Sticker #1 Current Club Sticker (See Below List of Clubs to Chose From) *Sticker #2 - Current Year ATV Maine Sticker
- 3) Clubs must be registered with the State of Maine and provide proof of:
- *Recognized as being in good standing with Corporations.

2) All machines including visitors are required to display two stickers:

- *Covered by State of Maine insurance policy.
- *Brian Bronson provides Irving Woodlands with current year status.
- 4) Clubs must be current members of ATV Maine and provide proof of: *Registered for current season.
 - *Purchased National Motorsports insurance policy. *Joy Harvey - ATV Maine contact that provides Irving Woodlands with current year status.
- 5) Irving Woodlands does not authorize ATV use off designated trails.
- 6) Irving Woodlands encourages Maine Warden and Forest Service active participation and enforcement of ATV laws
- of its members and visitors. 8) To operate on an Irving Woodlands Trail all users must demonstrate recognized club membership.

7) Irving Woodlands looks forward to working with those clubs that take responsibility for the conduct
