1. Riding on others' property is a privilege, not a right. The local ATV clubs work with the landowner to get permission to set up trails and maintain these trails. We hope that all ATV riders respect the land they are riding on and will stay on marked trails which have been marked with the landowner's approval.
2. It's come to the club's attention that many riders do not realize that in order to ride on most of the trails in this area, the ATVer must belong to a club that belongs to ATV of Maine and has the liability insurance required by Irving Woodlands. In order to ride on Irving Woodlands trails, you must display on your machine an updated, 2014, local sticker and an ATV of Maine sticker.
